



SEAPEX is strengthening its commitment in promoting petroleum geoscience expertise in Southeast Asia by introducing the “Dick Murphy Scholarship Award”.

If you are a Southeast Asia National (Singapore, Malaysia, Indonesia, Thailand, Vietnam, Philippines, Brunei, Cambodia, Laos and Myanmar) and have been awarded a provisional place to study a Master’s degree or equivalent in petroleum geosciences or other related discipline at a recognized university, then you may be eligible for a partial or full grant from SEAPEX.

To be eligible you must:-

- 1) Be a member or have applied for membership of SEAPEX
- 2) Complete the following form
- 3) Provide a copy of Bachelor’s degree / academic records
- 4) Submit recommendation letter from a previous course tutor / department head
- 5) Submit an endorsement letter and evidence of acceptance from host university
- 6) Provide any supporting document(s) that will aid your application

Guidelines, Terms and Conditions:

- ✓ Candidates must be members, or have applied for membership to SEAPEX.
- ✓ Candidates must have been offered a place on a petroleum geoscience related MSc course or equivalent at a recognized university.
- ✓ Potential candidates will require endorsement from their host institute.
- ✓ The award will be made to an individual rather than general support to an MSc course.
- ✓ The award will be provided by SEAPEX and administered by the university at which the student is attending.
- ✓ The award will be a one time grant and no individual will get multiple/repeated awards.
- ✓ Award will be given for Academic Year 2011/2012

Selection Process

- ✓ A SEAPEX Scholarship sub-committee will handle the selection process. The committee will then present its recommended candidate(s) to the SEAPEX Council for approval.
- ✓ Applicants who are full-time students without existing scholarship will be given preference in the selection process.
- ✓ Applicants must be inclined to do or is doing a thesis/paper covering SE Asia as additional credit will be given in the selection process
- ✓ Successful and unsuccessful candidates will be notified.

Award Amount

- ✓ Scholarship will be in the form of a lump sum with value to be determined by the SEAPEX Scholarship sub-committee (partial or full grant)
- ✓ SEAPEX Council will make the final decision to grant partial or full grant.
- ✓ SEAPEX Council reserves the right not to make any awards.

Award Disbursement

- ✓ The financial grant will be given directly to the individual in three parts corresponding to the university semesters so long as the student is still enrolled in the course/program and has good academic standing. Payment schedule may be revised depending on relevant academic year.
- ✓ Student will provide supporting documents prior to being given the subsequent payments. Failure to do so will result in cancellation of the award.
- ✓ The award of any grant will be at the sole discretion of the SEAPEX Council

Others

- ✓ Successful awardee/s is/are required to 1) obtain SEAPEX membership, 2) provide a copy of their thesis to SEAPEX, and 3) make a presentation during one of the SEAPEX meetings/conference.
